Sir,

With reference to your email dated 06.02.2025 on the above subject, it is to convey that the Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University, Opposite Shastri Maidan, Beside BVM College, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Dist. Anand, Gujarat, has been established/notified on 25.09.2019 by the Act of the State Legislature of Gujarat as a State (Private) University. Accordingly, the name of the University has been included in the list of universities established as per Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956, as maintained by UGC.

The University is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC vide Notification on "Specification of degrees, 2014" and its amendments issued from time to time under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, through its main campus in regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever required, after creating required academic and physical infrastructure facilities including library, laboratories and appointment of teaching and supporting staff as per the norms and standards laid down by UGC and other relevant Statutory Bodies/Councils.

The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University, Dist. Anand, Gujarat is not authorized to open study centre/off-campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State as per the observations of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Prof. Yashpal Vs State of Chhattisgarh (2005). The University cannot open its centre(s) even within the State as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003, without the approval of UGC.

The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off-campus/centre.

The University cannot offer its programmes through franchising arrangements with Private coaching institutions, even for the purpose of conducting courses through distance mode.

University can run courses through distance education mode only after getting prior approval from the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission, 35, Ferozeshah Road, New Delhi - 110 001.
